#EkKaamDeshKeNaam: Business leaders call for people to do something small but meaningful for the country

India@75 launched a campaign titled **Ek Kaam Desh Ke Naam** in which eminent industry leaders called for people to hoist the flag and resolve to do something for a better country.

- National Security Guard (NSG), with support from India@75, CII and Tata Motors will be flagging off a cavalcade on 2nd October 2021 as a part *Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav*.
- India@75 in collaboration with different stakeholders has designed a programme named 'Digital Volunteers'. This will leverage volunteers to ensure 100% functional literacy (digital & financial) across India. It will be launched by September 2021.
- Functional Literacy programme (FLiP) phase III will be initiated at 22 locations across the country in October 2021. The target is to reach approximately 6,000 individuals from the Economically Weaker Sections in India.
- CII has initiateed a podcast series. The first podcast themed 'India@75', has Mr TV Narendran, President, CII, in conversation with Mr Rajan Navani, Chair, CII Council on India@75. The link to the podcast will be shared in the next issue.
